BAN ON NOISE-MAKING AND FUNERAL ACTIVITIES IN OGUAA TRADITIONAL AREA

On behalf of the Oguaa Traditional Council, the Planning Committee for 2024 Oguaa Fetu Afahye hereby informs the general public of the customary ban on Noise-making and Funeral activities within the Oguaa Traditional Area starting **Tuesday 6th August, 2024 to Thursday 22nd August, 2024.**

Please be advised that during the ban period, the following activities are prohibited:

1. Excessive noise making of any sort
2. Quarrelling within the traditional area
3. Pounding of fufu after 6pm
4. Playing of drums (Churches should please note that volumes of PA systems and microphones should be kept low)
5. Wailing or mourning
6. Fishing on the Nana Kobina Fosu Lagoon until 3rd September, 2024.
7. Funeral activities until the 21st September, 2024.

The Oguaa Traditional Council counts on the support of churches, mosques, bars, lounges, restaurants, entertainment venues, corporate institutions and all residents in the traditional area to comply with the directives and respect the cultural practices and traditions of the Oguaa Traditional Area.

Please note further that Volunteers from the seven asafo companies would work with the Traditional Council to ensure compliance with the ban. Any offenders will be subject to sanctions as will be imposed by the Oguaa Traditional Council.
